August 15, 2024









First National Space Day Celebrated by

Dept. Of Physics

August 23, 2024

The department of Physics at Government College Shillai successfully celebrated India's first National Space Day, an event dedicated to honoring the success of the Chandrayaan-3 mission launched by ISRO (Indian Space Research Organisation), which landed on the South Pole of the Moon on August 23, 2023. The event featured a special lecture on the theme: "Touching Lives While Touching the Moon." It attracted students, faculty, and space enthusiasts alike. T event began with a welcome address by Prof. Sujata Khamn, who anchored the stage, warmly welcomed the audience, and introduced the context of the day's event. The special lecture was delivered by Dr. Sansar Chand, Assistant Professor in the Department of Physics, Government College Shillai. He explained various aspects of space research and thoroughly discussed the moon missions launched by ISRO. Dr. Sansar Chand emphasized the importance of Chandrayaan-3 and detailed the challenges overcome by ISRO in landing the Vikram lander and Pragyan rover on the lunar surface. He also elaborated on the concepts involved in launching a satellite and highlighted how ISRO is renowned for accomplishing cost effective and impactful missions. Additionally, Dr. Sansar Chand discussed ISRO's future deep space missions, including Aditya L1, Mangalyaan 2, Chandrayaan 4, and the Indian Space Station mission. The talk was interactive and included a quiz on space-related topics. This informative event was enjoyed by all attendees. Senior faculty member prof. Ajay Singh gave his concluding remarks on the event. The event concluded with the National Anthem.
