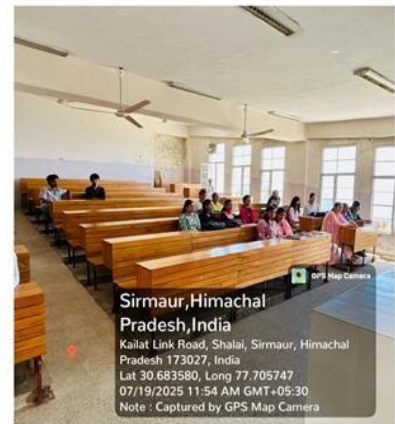

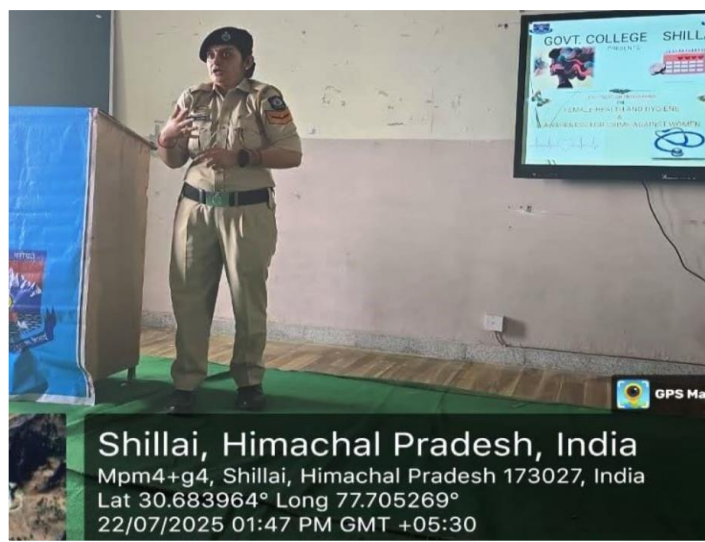
In the end, the Assistant Professor also told the students in detail about the importance of the population census. About 20 students of the Geography Department participated on the occasion of World Population Day.

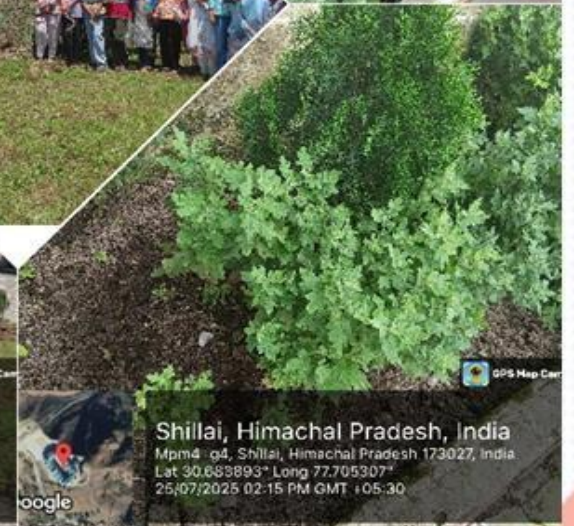
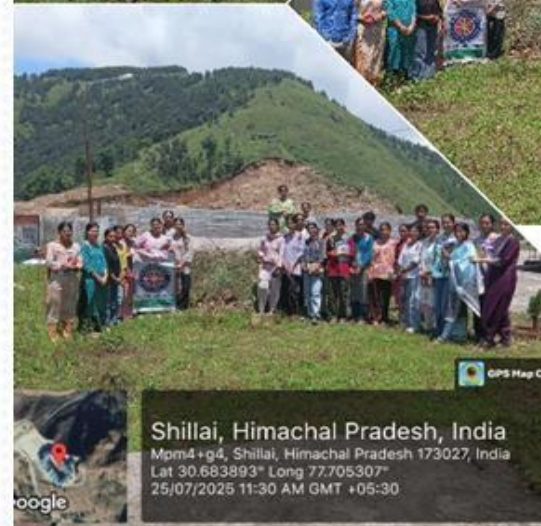
Cleanliness Drive Conducted

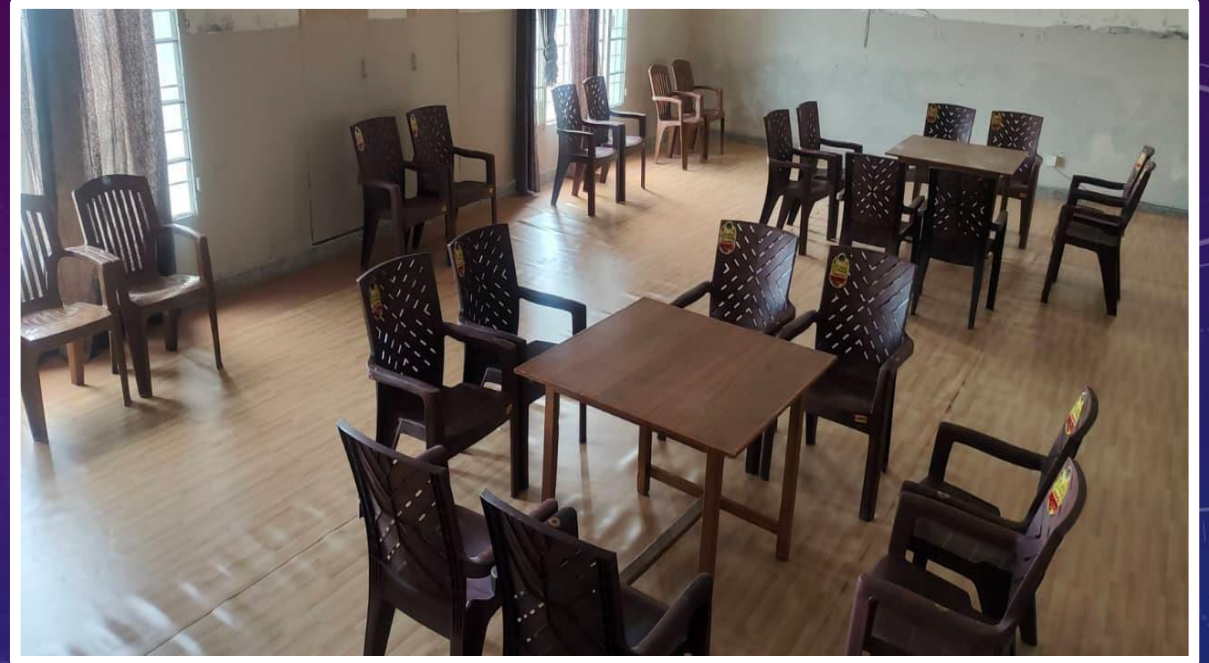

मुंशी प्रेमचंद जयंती

31 जुलाई, 2025

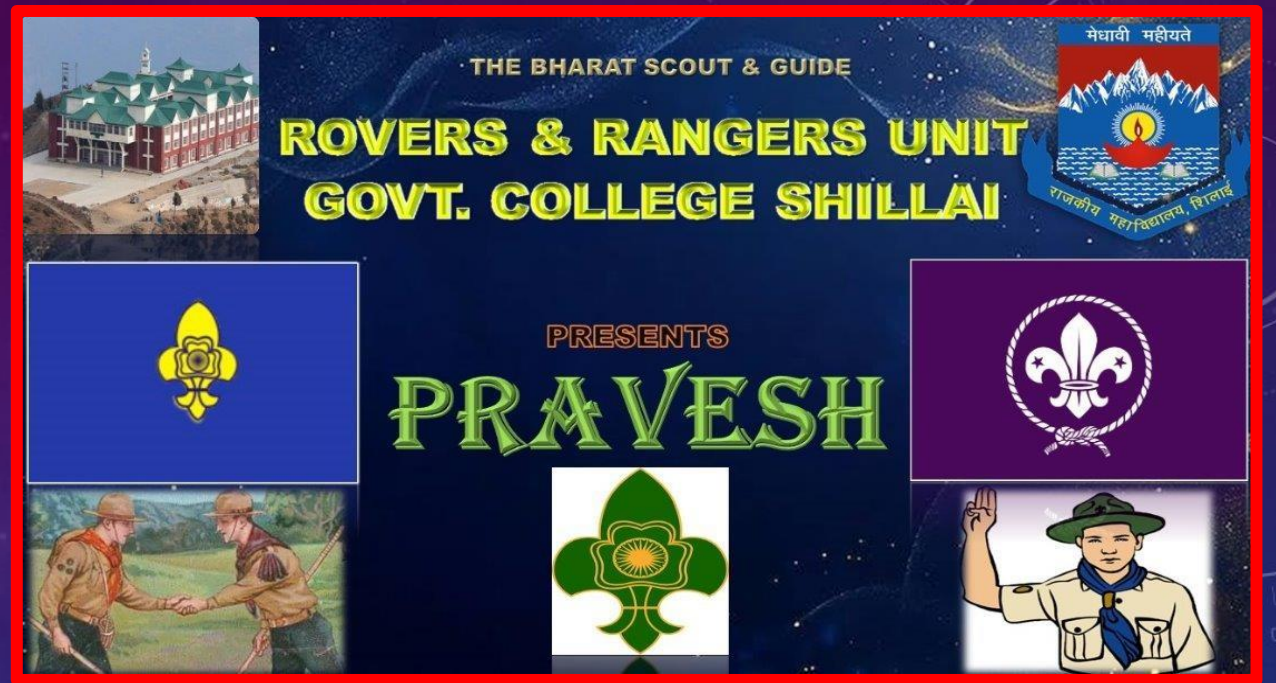


"Pravesh" Camp by Rovers and Rangers Unit GC Shillai

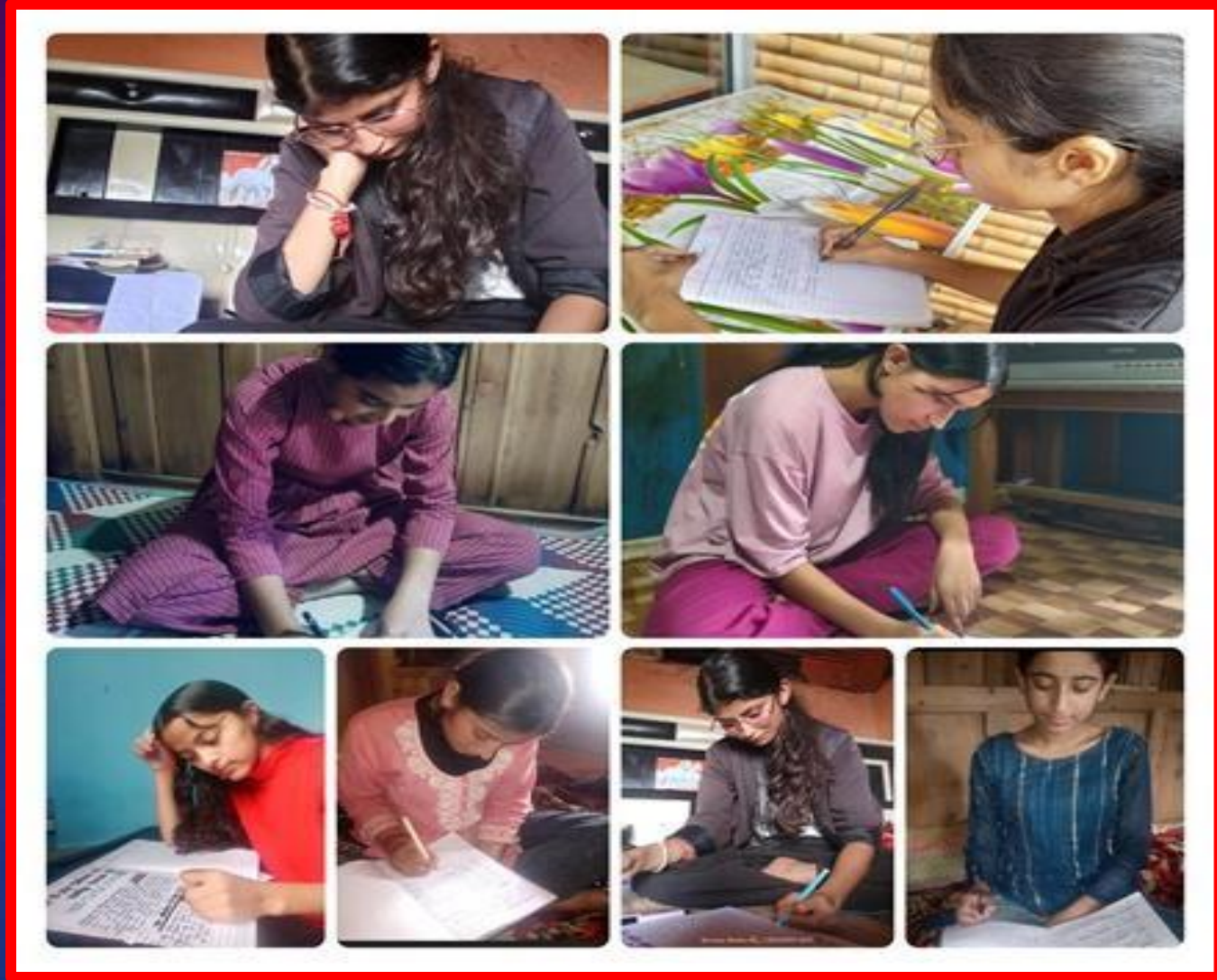

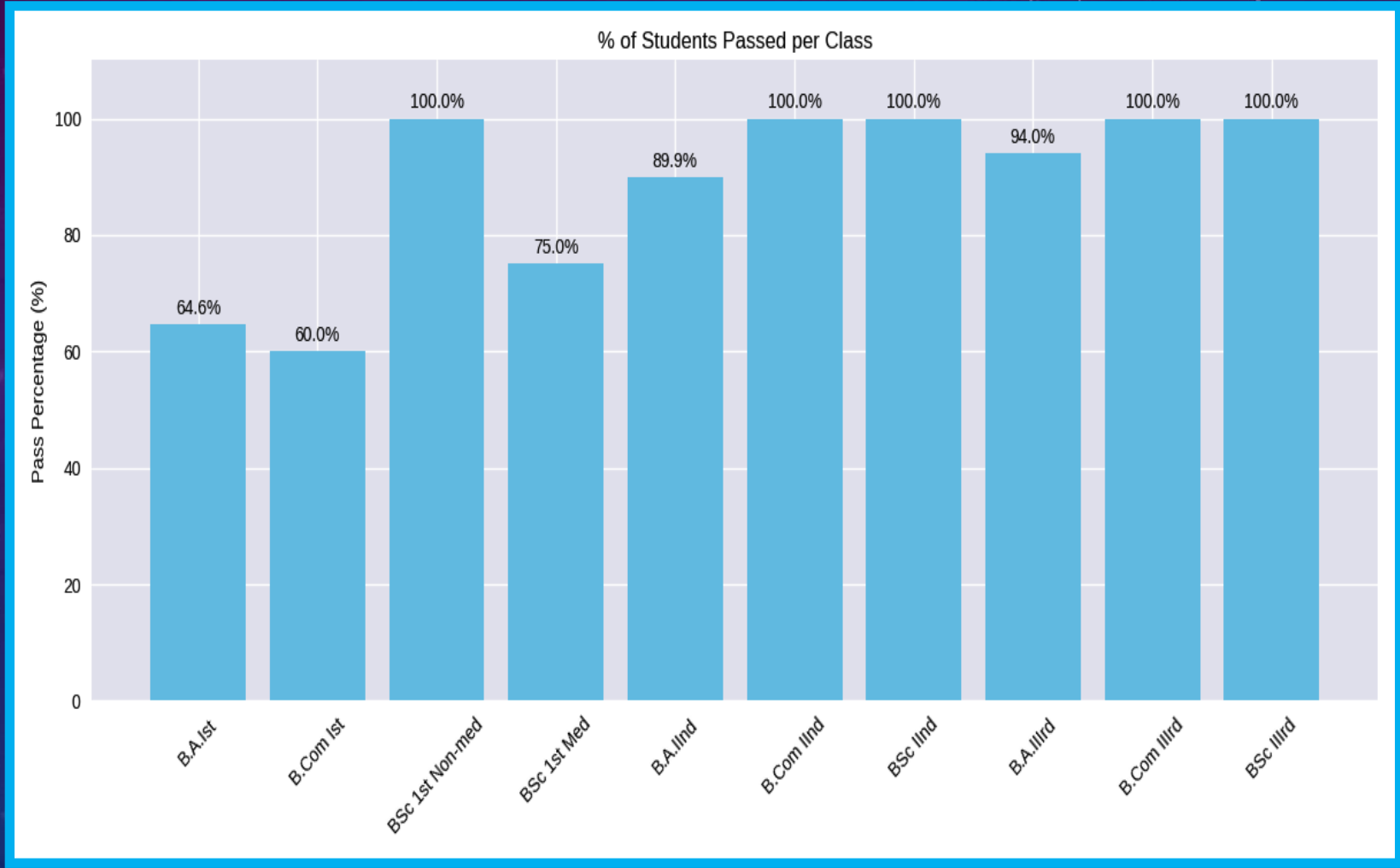

Annual Examination Results Session 2024-2025

The annual examination results of Government College Shillai reflect a satisfactory overall academic performance, with notable improvement in the senior classes. In the first year, B.A. students recorded pass percentages of 64.6 percent , B.Sc Non medical 1st year 100% and B.Sc 1st medical students recorded 75% pass percentage , while the B.Com. first year showed a percentage of 60 percentage. A marked improvement was observed in the second year, with B.A. students achieving an 89.9 percent pass rate and both B.Com 2nd. and B.Sc. Non medical 2nd securing 100 percent results.
